We are writing to provide you with some important information regarding Term 2 Remote Learning, due to commence on Monday.

Our teachers have been working hard to prepare learning plans for remote learning mode so your children can work effectively from home during this highly adaptive period of life in which we currently find ourselves in.

Hillbrook's approach to Remote Learning is to provide a structured framework that will enable your child to work as independently as possible, according to their year level, yet still feel supported by their teachers.

Our teachers will be on-hand to guide students and will provide clarity and certainty to their learning. They will meet with students every morning at 8:30am via Zoom for Daily Starter where rolls will be marked as well as providing an opportunity for Home Classes to connect. Your child's teachers will be regularly delivering content (via Zoom), setting tasks, monitoring, providing feedback and marking student work; just like they normally do.
