

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update #18 – 29 July 2020

As you may be aware a positive case of COVID-19 at Parklands Christian College, linked to NSW, has been confirmed this morning. This is a clear reminder that COVID-19 is still with us and we need to continue to keep each other safe.

With this in mind, and given community transmission in NSW appears to be spreading, we are now asking that **from today**, if students or anyone they reside with **travel anywhere in NSW**, they should **not attend school** for 14 days from the return date. The same applies for any families having visitors staying with them from NSW.

Also, if you have been anywhere in NSW from 20 July onwards, we would appreciate you replying to this email to let us know as we are keeping records should we need them for future contact tracing.

We are still maintaining strict hygiene measures and will continue to do what we can to keep our community safe.

It is extremely important that you keep your children home if they are displaying any cold or flu like symptoms and you contact your GP if they display any of the following symptoms: sore throat, cough, fever, fatigue, tight chest, loss of sense of taste or smell or an upset stomach. If anyone in your household or a close contact is awaiting a COVID-19 test result, your child must also remain home until a negative result is received.

We will continue to assess our planned events and will keep you advised.
