



## Position Description Mathematics Teacher (Full Time)

### The School

Hillbrook is a co-educational school of 780 students from Years 7-12, established in 1987. The school offers a broad range of General subjects, and while the majority of graduates go on to study at university, a number also move into trades and employment. The school's motto, 'In Balance We Grow', underpins life at Hillbrook, which prides itself on its focus on quality teaching and learning within contemporary learning environments, and a specialisation in the nurturing of adolescents. We aspire to provide all members of our staff and student body with support in a community environment. Students are encouraged to engage in a range of pursuits to achieve a balance between the academic, creative, physical and spiritual aspects of their lives.

The school actively encourages and supports teachers in furthering their own professional development. Our commitment extends to a variety of options, including study leave, generous professional development opportunities, and access to Highly Accomplished and Lead Teacher national certification. Staff at Hillbrook are encouraged to become involved in the collegial ethos of the school. All applicants would need to be supportive of the values of an independent Anglican school.

**Duties** Mathematics Teacher (Full Time)

**Position description** The successful applicant will teach in our Mathematics subject area.

Duties and responsibilities include:

- Being involved in curriculum development and mathematics teaching pedagogy;
- Being involved in professional dialogue within the subject area to ensure coherent programs with strong links across year levels;
- Completing all assessment and reporting tasks in a timely manner;
- Attending regular meetings for planning and discussion, encouraging collegiality, and be willing to being involved in professional development opportunities;
- Using student data to inform teaching and learning in the classroom;
- Communicating with the school community on initiatives, student achievements and other relevant issues;
- Being supportive of the School's Outdoor Education program; and
- Being involved in the school's Pastoral Care program, including Home Class Teacher duties.

**Essential competencies and qualifications**

The successful applicant must have:

- Experience teaching Mathematical Methods and Specialist Mathematics;
- Experience with QCAA processes such as Endorsement and Confirmation;
- Completed accreditation courses via the QCAA and hold (or have a desire to hold) roles within the QCAA;
- Experience in extension and enrichment programs in Mathematics;
- A passion for teaching and for learning;
- Exceptional interpersonal and organisational skills;
- Experience in innovative curriculum development;
- Ability to form positive and productive relationships with students, parents and colleagues;
- Registration, or the ability to be registered, with the Queensland College of Teachers; and
- Highly Accomplished Teachers and Lead Teachers accreditation (highly desirable but not essential).

**Conditions, entitlements and benefits**

- The position is a full time position, with a view to permanency, commencing in January 2021.
- The position is paid in accordance with the Anglican Schools Enterprise Agreement.
- Personal leave accrues at 10 days per annum.
- Long Service Leave accrues at the rate of 1.3 weeks for each completed year of service with entitlements accessible after 7 years continuous service.
- Employer superannuation of 12.75% is available where staff make voluntary contributions of 5%. Employer superannuation is paid in addition to salary.
- Access to Highly Accomplished Teacher and Lead Teacher National Certification.
