Next Step 2020 Post-School Destinations

This is a summary of the post-school destinations of students from Hillbrook Anglican School who completed Year 12 and gained a Senior Statement in 2019. The results are from the *Year 12 Completers Survey*, which is conducted approximately six months after students completed Year 12.

84.8% response rate

95 out of 112 Year 12 completers from this school responded to the 2020 survey. Results may not be representative of all Year 12 completers at this school.

Post-school destinations



In 2020, 90.5% of Year 12 completers from Hillbrook Anglican School were engaged in education, training or employment in the year after they completed school.



Of the 95 respondents, 80.0% continued in some recognised form of education and training. The most common study destination was bachelor degree.




A further 10.5% transitioned directly into paid employment and no further study.

All Year 12 completers were assigned to a *main destination*. Respondents who were both studying and working are reported as being in education or training, including apprentices and trainees.
