The SLT and our Year 12 Coordinator, Vicki Hansen, will also be holding an 'Open House' Zoom Session to answer any questions parents may have from 6-7pm on Thursday 27 August. We will send out information soon.

In the final 2 weeks of Term 3, the 'Mock Block' will begin. Teachers will mark these practice exams and provide feedback to students during Term 4. The 'Mock Block' will be like normal blocks where students only attend if they have a mock exam.

Students will also continue to complete their QTAC applications, apply for universities or explore other training or employment options this term. It is still very important for students to focus on the present workload, which will give them a broader range of options for tertiary study and future work.

In Term 4, students will attend all classes in week 1 to receive their 'Mock Block' feedback.

In weeks 2 and 3, students will engage in flexible teaching modes including face-to-face teaching, tutorials and negotiated time. External exams occur in weeks 4-7 and exam dates are in our Assessment Calendar. These exams occur at Hillbrook and students only attend if they have an exam.

Our end of year celebrations are a fantastic way to cap off the year. This includes Celebration Evening and Graduation Dinner. Our farewell assembly is still scheduled to go ahead as we say goodbye to our Year 12s for the last time.

To say this year has been challenging is an understatement, but your resilience and unwavering commitment to the Hillbrook community and your learning has been wonderful. We are very proud of you.
