COVID UPDATE #5/2021

With the school holidays only a day away, we are writing to let you know the Queensland Government has today announced a change for all Queensland residents when travelling interstate.

From 1am Saturday, 19 June 2021 **all Queensland residents will need to complete either a Travel Declaration or a Border Pass to return to Queensland if travelling interstate.**

Whether you need a Declaration or a Border Pass will depend on whether or not the state you are in has any declared hotspots and this might have an impact your return to Queensland. You can read full details [here](#).

There are currently three new cases in Sydney, and while it hasn't yet been declared a hotspot, this can change quickly.

We ask that you keep up to date with any declared hotspots and active contact tracing alert locations. You can find all the locations [here](#).

We hope you are able to enjoy a break and, if you are travelling, you are able to do so safely and without any COVID cancellations or restrictions.
