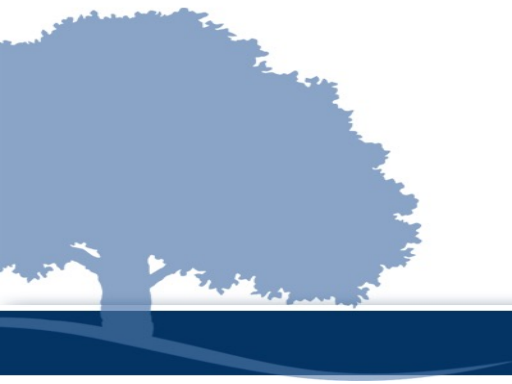

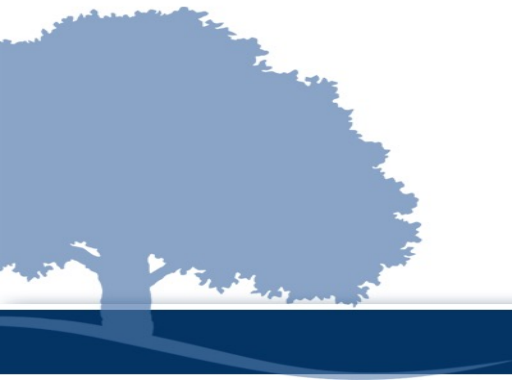
**Mandatory Electives:** Digital Technologies, Food Technology, Art, Drama, Industrial Technology, Music, German, Japanese
